the college's students and staff. It is located on the west-central side of campus.

The building rises 5 levels, with 2 additional levels below grade. A Limestone and glass exterior provides a modern look, while maintaining the overall aesthetic of surrounding campus buildings. At the entrance is a large 4-story atrium with abundant natural lighting. This building is recognized as LEED 2.1 Silver by the United States Green Building Council (USGBC). It also marks the first building by Adjustable Forms to be LEED certified.
